Schedule of Classes

CLASS 1: CHRISTMAS CONUNDRUM: TAKE YOUR OWN LINE

CLASS 2: ROCKING AROUND THE CHRISTMAS TREE

CLASS 3: BAUBLE & SPOON STEEPLECHASE

CLASS 4: SANTA EXPRESS

Only jumps and tunnels will be used for each of the classes in this show – There will be no weaves or contact equipment in any classes.

As with all of our shows, we will be providing a separate set of awards for beginners (dogs in KC grades 1-3) and advanced (dogs in KC grades 4-7). All grades will run over the same courses but for separate awards. There will be no running orders for this show.

The £15 entry fee will include entry into all four classes for your level, plus a Christmas buffet lunch and a Christmas present for your dog! If you will be bringing any additional people with you, please could I ask that you send an additional £3 per person if they would also like the buffet lunch.

All grades may compete for competition or run 'NFC' and train in the ring. You may run at a lower height than you are eligible for, but this will be for a clear round only (CRO). You may use a toy or food for NFC rounds but please do not use any treats which may crumble and be careful not to drop anything which may distract other dogs.

The course for each class will be the same for all heights and can be walked before the start of each class – there will be no time for walking the course between height changes!

Once classes 1 & 2 have finished, we will stop the rings for a lunchbreak, where a festive buffet lunch will be provided for all competitors. We will also award the fancy dress prizes during this lunch break. Classes 3 & 4 will then take place after lunch at approximately 1pm.

Results from this show will not count towards the 2017-2018 winter series.

Special Prizes

There will be a number of 'on the spot' prizes awarded to dogs and handlers throughout the day....These may be for particularly impressive handling or even the most entertaining dog......

There will also be special festive awards for fancy dress and other festive themes!

Class Definitions:

CHRISTMAS CONUNDRUM: TAKE YOUR OWN LINE:

This class will consist of 15 obstacles, set up in no particular order, with the exception of the start and finish jumps. Each obstacle must be taken once, but the handler will decide how to negotiate them. The dog to complete all 15 obstacles in the fastest time, will win the class. If an obstacle is taken more than once, or the finish jump is crossed before all other obstacles have been completed, the dog will be eliminated. Each obstacle will have a number assigned to it, but this will be only to assist the judge and will not be of relevance to competitors.

ROCKING AROUND THE CHRISTMAS TREE:

There will be a 'tree' in the middle of the course, with four sequences set around it. The dog and handler will start next to Santa (through the timing gates) and will need to complete each sequence, circling the tree between each one. Once all sequences have been completed the handler will need to run back to Santa (and back through the timing gates) to stop the clock. Only the dog is required to circle the tree between the sequences, but handlers will not be penalised for running around the tree with their dog. The dog and handler to negotiate all sequences successfully in the fastest time will win the class. The sequences can be negotiated in any order, but must only be completed once.

BAUBLE & SPOON STEEPLECHASE:

This class will be a simple, circular steeplechase course, but the handler must complete the course whilst balancing a bauble on a spoon. The handler will incur 5 faults each time the bauble falls off of the spoon.....this class will especially suit those who are able to handle their dogs from a distance!! If the bauble is dropped, the handler will need to return to the bauble and replace it on the spoon before they are able to continue with the course. If the handler continues with the course without returning to collect the bauble - or is caught holding the bauble on the spoon - they will be eliminated!

SANTA EXPRESS:

A simple up and down course, but the handler must put on one piece of Christmas clothing at the end of each line of jumps - three in total. Handlers may leave their dog in a long wait at the beginning of the course, but cannot put the first item of clothing on before their dog starts the clock. Handlers must be wearing all three pieces of additional clothing when they cross the finish line. The dog to get around the course in the fastest time will win. Handlers not wearing all pieces of additional clothing when their dog crosses the finish line will be eliminated!

Dog Height Categories and Jump Heights:

Small: dogs measuring 350mm and below - Jump height 300mm.

Medium: dogs measuring over 350mm and below 430mm - Jump height 400mm.

Standard: dogs measuring over 430mm can choose whether to jump at standard or large – Jump height 500mm.

Large: dogs measuring over 430mm can choose whether to jump at standard or large – Jump height 600mm.

Awards

Rosettes and prizes will be awarded to dogs placed to at least third in each class. Results may be combined for small & medium dogs and standard & large dogs, if class entries are small. Clear round rosettes will be available for all classes.

Plus!! Special prizes for dogs and handlers, awarded from any of the show organisers....These could be for anything, so everybody has a chance of winning!

Plus!!! A Christmas pressie for all dogs running on the day of the show!

Exercise Area

We are very lucky to have the opportunity to run these shows at such a lovely venue, but please note that Priory Equestrian is a working yard and horses will be on site at all times. For this reason, we do not have the option of offering an offlead exercise area for your dogs. Frensham common is within walking distance of the venue and we hope this will be a suitable alternative for anybody wanting to exercise their dog off –lead during the show.

Show Rules

Please read our show rules carefully. You agree to abide by them when signing the Declaration!

- 1. We reserve the right to refuse entries.
- 2. Entries limited to 180 dogs. If the maximum number of dogs is reached before the official closing date, entries will be declared closed at that earlier date.
- 3. Changes may be made to the level or height your dog is entered into after sending your entry, but only up to and including the closing date of the show.
- 4. Please keep all dogs on lead (except when competing) and ensure you clean up after vour dogs.
- 5. All dogs entered for competition at this show must be 15 months of age or over.
- 6. Any person handling their own or any other dog in a harsh manner will be asked to leave the show.
- 7. A dog will be removed from the competition if it is: so out of control that it poses a danger to people or dogs at the show; or suffering from an infectious or contagious disease, or otherwise unfit to compete.
- 8. The show manager and show secretary will be the sole arbiters in respect of all matters and disputes at this event.
- 9. Competitors must follow the instructions of the Stewards with respect to parking and conduct within the show boundaries.
- 10. In the event that the competition has to be cancelled, we reserve the right to deduct unrecoverable expenses incurred before returning entry fees.
- 11. Whilst every care will be taken, we will not take responsibility for loss, damage or injury to dogs, people or property whilst at this show.
- 12. Goods may not be sold at the venue without prior permission.
- 13. Running orders will not be drawn. It is your responsibility to make sure you are available to run in your jump height before the class closes.
- 14. Standard marking will apply unless indicated by the judge at the briefing
- 15. Eligibility for classes and rules for training and competition rounds can be found on page 2 of this schedule.
- 16. For the purposes of show processing and scoring at the event, your details will be entered into a computer system and stored in accordance with GDPR. Show results will be published online at agility-time.net.

How to find us!


FROM A3

From Hindhead, take A287 towards Farnham, going through Churt village and on to FRENSHAM. The Priory will be on your right, 100 metres after the school and green on your left. It is 5.7 miles from Hindhead to FRENSHAM.

FROM M3 Junction 4

Take A331 to meet A31. Take A31 to Farnham (Winchester direction)

At traffic lights turn left, over railway crossing and shortly on to traffic lights. Turn right. At next traffic lights turn left onto A287, towards Hindhead. The Priory will be on your left very shortly after the left turn to FRENSHAM Little Pond. It is 9.5 miles from Junction 4 to the traffic lights on the A31 and then 3.2 miles to FRENSHAM.
