#### **Schedule of Classes**

CLASS 1:	BEGINNERS AGILITY
CLASS 2:	<b>BEGINNERS AGILITY 2</b>
CLASS 3:	BEGINNERS JUMPING
CLASS 4:	BEGINNERS STEEPLECHASE
CLASS 5:	ADVANCED AGILITY
CLASS 6:	ADVANCED AGILITY 2
CLASS 7:	ADVANCED JUMPING
CLASS 8:	ADVANCED STEEPLECHASE

Classes 1, 2, 3 & 4 are open to dogs in KC grades 1-3 and classes 5, 6, 7 & 8 are for dogs in KC grades 4-7. Please note that you will need to run at the same level for all available classes, ie/ you can enter classes 1-4 or 5-8, but you could not enter Beginners Agility and Advanced Jumping.

Classes are charged at £3.50 each and there will also be an option to buy a **'second chance'** ticket which will entitle you to a second attempt at any one of the four courses. If you do choose to run any of the classes twice, your better run will count towards the awards for that class and the points for the winter league.

All grades may compete for competition or run 'NFC' and train in the ring. You may run at a lower height than you are eligible for, but this will be for a clear round only (CRO). You can change your entry to NFC or CRO on the day of the show. You may use a toy or food for NFC rounds but please do not use any treats which may crumble and be careful not to drop anything which may distract other dogs.

The course for each class will be the same for all heights and can be walked before the start of each class – there will be no time for walking the course between height changes! Please make sure that you are available to run at the correct height. Electronic timing will be used.

Winter Series: Points will be accumulated for the league from each class throughout the winter. You do not need to enter all of the shows to enter the league – all results from each show will automatically be entered into the league table. Dogs with the highest accumulative points over the 3 shows will be awarded the title of series champion. There will be awards for the series champion and reserve champion for each height and level, with an overall prize for the tournament champion, across all heights and levels. This year, only clear rounds will be awarded points.

Please note that dogs do not need to be KC registered to enter the show and do not need to be officially measured.

# **Dog Height Categories and Jump Heights:**

**Small:** dogs measuring 350mm and below - Jump height 300mm.

Medium: dogs measuring over 350mm and below 430mm - Jump height 400mm.

**Standard:** dogs measuring over 430mm can choose whether to jump at standard or large – Jump height 500mm.

**Large:** dogs measuring over 430mm can choose whether to jump at standard or large – Jump height 600mm.

# <u>Awards</u>

Rosettes and prizes will be awarded to dogs placed to at least third in each class. Results may be combined for small & medium dogs and standard & large dogs, if class entries are small. Clear round rosettes will be available for all classes.

There will be a special prize for the highest scoring ABC (anything but collie) dog, which has not already achieved a series prize, at the end of the series. We are very grateful to Lyn Hatcher for sponsoring this award.

Once again, the below league prizes have been very generously **sponsored by Nutriment** and all winners will receive a hamper, trophy and rosette.

### Exercise Area

We are very lucky to have the opportunity to run these shows at such a lovely venue, but please note that Priory Equestrian is a working yard and horses will be on site at all times. For this reason, we do not have the option of offering an off-lead exercise area for your dogs. Frensham common is within walking distance of the venue and we hope this will be a suitable alternative for anybody wanting to exercise their dog off –lead during the show.

# **Show Rules**

# Please read our show rules carefully. You agree to abide by them when signing the Declaration!

- 1. We reserve the right to refuse entries.
- 2. Entries limited to 200 dogs per show. If the maximum number of dogs is reached before the official closing date, entries will be declared closed at that earlier date.
- 3. Changes may be made to the level or height your dog is entered into after sending your entry, but only up to and including the closing date of the show.
- 4. Please keep all dogs on lead (except when competing) and ensure you clean up after your dogs.
- 5. All dogs entered for competition at this show must be 16 months of age or over.
- 6. Any person handling their own or any other dog in a harsh manner will be asked to leave the show.
- 7. A dog will be removed from the competition if it is: so out of control that it poses a danger to people or dogs at the show; or suffering from an infectious or contagious disease, or otherwise unfit to compete.
- 8. The show manager and show secretary will be the sole arbiters in respect of all matters and disputes at this event.
- 9. Competitors must follow the instructions of the Stewards with respect to parking and conduct within the show boundaries.
- 10. In the event that the competition has to be cancelled, we reserve the right to deduct unrecoverable expenses incurred before returning entry fees.
- 11. Whilst every care will be taken, we will not take responsibility for loss, damage or injury to dogs, people or property whilst at this show.
- 12. Goods may not be sold at the venue without prior permission.
- 13. Running orders will be sent out in advance of the show. It is your responsibility to make sure you are available to run in your jump height before the class closes.
- 14. Standard marking will apply unless indicated by the judge at the briefing
- 15. Eligibility for classes and rules for training and competition rounds can be found on page 2 of this schedule.
- 16. For the purposes of show processing and scoring at the event, your details will be entered into a computer system and stored in accordance with GDPR. Show results will be published online at agility-time.net.

# How to find us!


#### FROM A3

From Hindhead, take A287 towards Farnham, going through Churt village and on to FRENSHAM. The Priory will be on your right, 100 metres after the school and green on your left. It is 5.7 miles from Hindhead to FRENSHAM.

#### FROM M3 Junction 4

Take A331 to meet A31. Take A31 to Farnham (Winchester direction)

At traffic lights turn left, over railway crossing and shortly on to traffic lights. Turn right. At next traffic lights turn left onto A287, towards Hindhead. The Priory will be on your left very shortly after the left turn to FRENSHAM Little Pond. It is 9.5 miles from Junction 4 to the traffic lights on the A31 and then 3.2 miles to FRENSHAM.
