COVID-19 Restrictions

If a competitor, or anyone in their household, has Covid-19 related symptoms or has tested positive for Covid-19 they must not attend the show

EQUIPMENT: Weald will be using our own equipment; all contacts have rubber surfaces.

Prizes and Trophies: TROPHIES TO FIRST PLACE ONLY, ROSETTES: 1st 2nd AND 3rd PLACE ONLY. Clear round rosettes in all classes to be collected on the day

CLASSES

Run generally as Kennel Club Rules. Large/Intermediate (results combined), Medium, Small and Micro (small/micro results combined).

Class 1 – 1-2 Combined Agility

Class 2 – 3-5 Combined Agility

Class 3 - 1-2 Combined Jumping

Class 4 - 3-5 Combined Jumping

Class 5 - 1-5 Combined Steeplechase (no weaves)

ELIGIBILITY FOR CLASSES

Agility classes to include contact obstacles and Jumping classes where there are no contact obstacles. Weaves will be included in both. The rings will be fenced.

Training in the ring will be permitted. The handler must tell the scime before the run and the run will be NFC. Toys will be allowed but no food treats. The handler will be allowed no more than the maximum course time and should leave the ring by the most direct route upon request from the judge.

Higher grade dogs may enter NFC (not for competition) All large dogs will run at Intermediate height with combined results. Micro enter as small and height will be adjusted on the day, results combined with small.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Entry fee will be £15.00 per dog for all 3 classes. Payment accepted via cash, cheque or Bacs.
2. There will be no prize money
3. Internet entries will be accepted <http://agility-time.net/weald>
4. The Committee reserves the right to refuse entries.
5. Only dogs of 18 calendar months of age and over on the day of competition are eligible for competition
6. No bitch in season is allowed to compete.
7. No person shall carry out punitive correction or harsh handling of a dog at any time within the boundaries of the Show.
8. Dogs must not wear any type of slip, half-slip collar harness or lead when under test. A flat, close fitting, leather or webbing collar is permitted, providing the only attachment is a plain identification panel as an integral part of the collar ie. not attached by a ring.
9. Should the judge be unable to fulfill the appointment to judge the Committee reserves the right to appoint another judge.
10. No competitor shall impugn the decision of the judge or judges.
11. Kennel Club standard marking regulations apply for all standard classes.
12. Height of jumps will be as follows;- Large will jump Intermediate, Intermediate 500mm, Medium 400mm, Small 300mm and Micro 250mm

The height limit for dogs.

Large Dog classes - For dogs measuring over 500mm at the withers.

Intermediate dog classes - For dogs measuring over 430mm at the withers and under 500mm

Medium Dog classes - For dogs measuring over 350mm and measuring 430mm or under at the withers.

Small Dog classes - For dogs measuring 350mm or under at the withers.

Dogs wishing to jump Micro can jump 250mm

13. Withdrawal of dogs from Competition: A dog shall be withdrawn from competition and removed from the Show if it is:-
 - a. A bitch which is in season.
 - b. Suffering from any infectious diseases or contagious disease.
 - c. Interfering with the safety or chance of winning of an opponent.
 - d. Of such temperament or so much out of hand as to be a danger to the safety of any person or other animal.
 - e. Likely to cause suffering to the dog if it continues competing.
14. Should circumstances so dictate the Society, in consultation with the Judges, may alter arrangements as necessary.
15. In the event that the show is cancelled due to unforeseen circumstances, the Club/Society will on receipt of a stamped, addressed envelope refund fees to all those that had entered and requested a refund within 1 month of the show date, less reasonably incurred expenses.
16. Food shall not be carried in the hand or given to a dog in the ring.
17. Should the judge deem a re-run is required, any result and/or faults gained in the previous run must be discounted.
18. Separate entry forms must be completed by each owner and must be signed by the owner or his authorised agent in accordance with provisions specified thereon. Entry forms must be accompanied by the appropriate fees.
19. It is the competitor's responsibility to be available for their class and running order. Competitors must run as close to their running order as possible.

For the purposes of show processing and scoring at the event your details will be entered into a computer system and stored in accordance with GDPR. Show results will be published online at agility-time.net

Welfare of Dogs

An exhibitor (or competitor) whose dog is entered at this event should take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dog(s) are met, and should not knowingly put their dogs' health and welfare at risk by any action, default, omission or otherwise.

For new competitors:-

Only dogs that take part in Agility Training at a recognised Agility club may enter.

There is no need for the dog to be registered with the Kennel Club or any other organisation.

If you do not have a KC grading enter as grade 1.

Dogs do not need to be measured. If in doubt about your dog's height seek assistance from your trainer.
